AÇU PLACES RIO DE JANEIRO STATE ON THE AGRIBUSINESS MAP

In 2020, Port of Açu **imported fertilizers** for the first time in history, placing Rio de Janeiro's State on the agribusiness map.

WORLD-CLASS BONDED MULTICARGO TERMINAL

Through its world-class bonded multicargo terminal, Açu is able to receive Panamax vessels with the shortest waiting time in the region. In 2023, Açu **handled soybeans and corn to export**, showcasing our operational efficiency to clients. By entering the agribusiness sector, Açu establishes itself as a **key gateway for exporting Brazilian grains globally.**

RAILWAY CONNECTIVITY

With 3.0 million tons per year arriving through road connections, the railway project under development will also enable an increase in grain export capacity to **8.0 million tons per year after 2030.**



GRAIN TERMINAL

With a **dedicated grain terminal**, Port of Açú will consolidate its position as an essential part in the agribusiness value chain, facilitating the shipment of **3.5 million tons of grains** from the regions of Southeast and Midwest Brazil to global markets.

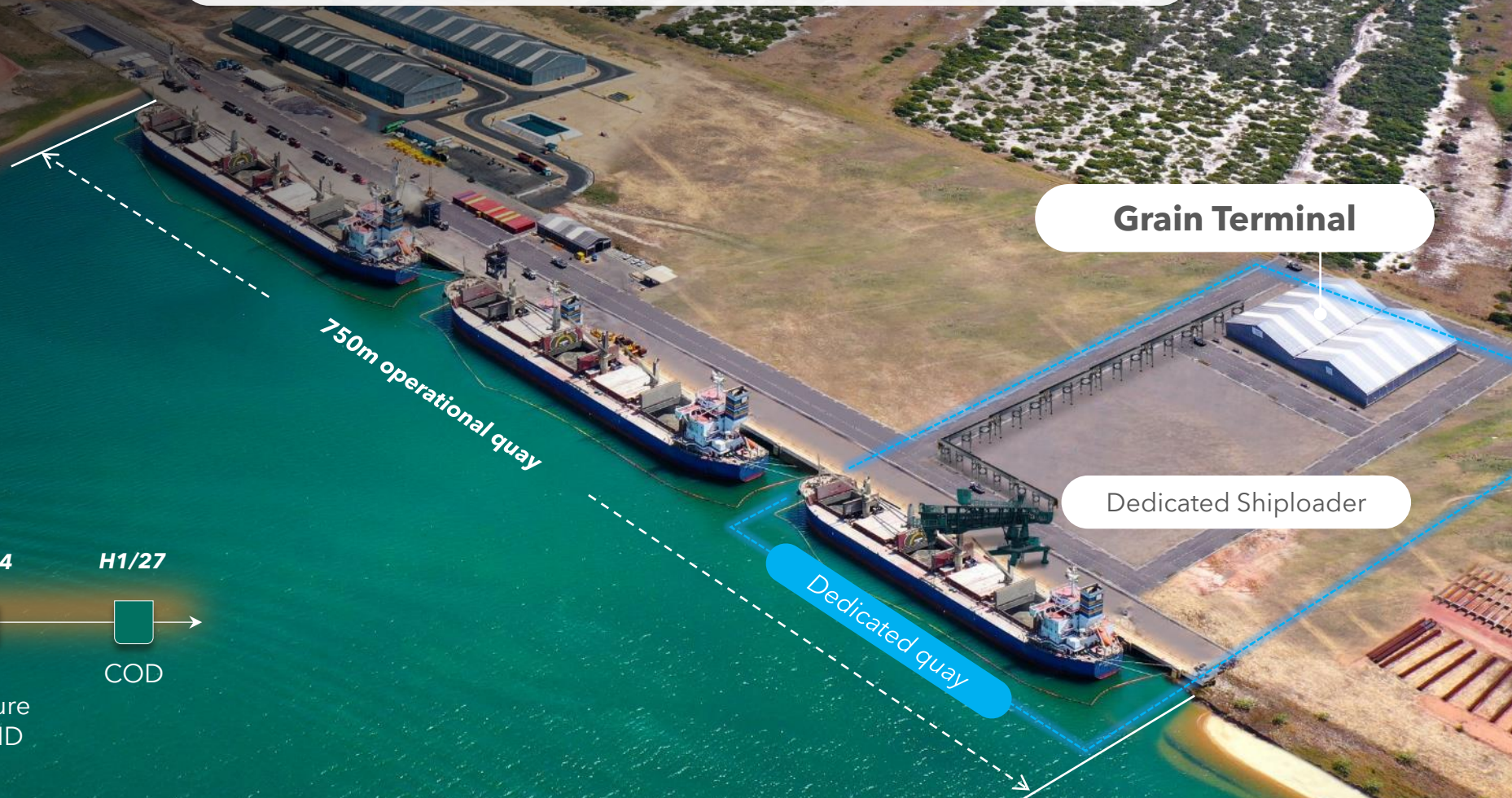
